

Guidelines for Langley Worship Services

- All worship services and announcements are on the website at www.langleycog.org
- 2. We will operate in a hybrid fashion, that means, we will have both our website services, plus we will now open the sanctuary slowly and begin to have inperson Sunday services for one hour. Service time: 11-12 noon
- 3. Prayerfully decide which service is best for you. The Lord will meet you, regardless of your choice.
- 4. Our website services will be live-streamed from the sanctuary worship services and can be viewed on YouTube at https://www.youtube.com/c/LangleycogOrg6159 and Facebook https://www.facebook.com/langleyavenuechurch
- 5. For our one-hour services in the sanctuary, the following guidelines will be in place in order to provide the safest and healthiest environment for everyone:
 - A. Enter at the 6159 Langley door only.
 - B. Anyone needing to use the chair lift, inform the ushers at the 6159 door, and they will have someone to meet you at the side door.
 - C. Temperatures will be taken before admittance. Anyone with a temperature of OVER one hundred degrees, or anyone with excessive coughing is kindly asked not to enter the sanctuary.
 - D. Masks are mandatory in order to enter into and to remain in the sanctuary. Masks will always be provided at the door.
 - E. Social distancing will be practiced in the sanctuary. Seating will be led by the ushers.
 - F. At the end of the service, the pastor will dismiss by sections. All fellowship must be done outside or in the parking lot.
 - G. The lower level of the church is closed except for the bathrooms. Please do not gather in the lower level.
- 6. In the event you need to remove your mask, please step outside the church. If you are over the age of 60 you may remain in the vestibule
- 7. Until further notice, there will be no Sunday School hour, Children's Church, or meetings prior to, or following worship services.
- 8. Kitchen facilities are off limits for the time being.
- 9. We thank you in advance for your cooperation, your prayers, and your understanding. The Lord blesses those who dwell together in unity.
